

Scholarships Terms & Conditions

- 1. Scholarships are applicable to new students only. Application submitted by current students will not be considered.
- 2. Upon applying for scholarship, the applicants consent to the below terms and conditions will be considered as given.
- 3. Scholarship number is limited. Meeting the scholarship criteria does not mean that scholarship will be awarded.
- 4. The university has the right to request further documents and proofs depending on the scholarship. Applicants who are unable to provide the requested document within two weeks will forfeit their right to apply for any scholarship.
- 5. Scholarship application will be considered after the applicant completes the university's enrolment form and received/accepted an offer letter.
- 6. The university's advanced payment has to be completed within two calendar weeks from the time the applicant receives the scholarship confirmation letter, otherwise the scholarship will be forfeited and the applicant will not be allowed to apply again.
- 7. Applicant cannot obtain more than one scholarship. If an applicant meets the requirement for more than one scholarship, the highest scholarship will be awarded if available.
- 8. Scholarships are not available if the programme has been discounted unless specified.
- 9. The scholarship amount will be adjusted against the applicant's last payment.
- 10. Scholarship is applicable on tuition fees, applicant must cover the full cost of all other services. For example: books, printing, miscellaneous requests, graduation fees..etc

Scholarships termination

The university has the right to terminate the scholarship if the applicant:

- 1. Failed to maintain good academic standing.
- 2. Failed to maintain the eligibility criteria during the study.
- 3. Failed to make payments on time.
- 4. Has been suspended for misconduct under the University or Dubai International Academic City rule of conduct.
- 5. Provided false information.
- 6. Exiting the programme for any reason.

Consequences of termination

If the scholarship is terminated, the applicant may be required to pay some or all of the scholarship.

Appeal

Applicant may send an email with any grievance to scholarships@buid.ac.ae. The appeal decision is final and will not be subject to any further appeal.
